Saco Ranger District Snowmobile Trail Information
Winter 2009/2010

Due to timber sale activity, it is expected that Slippery Brook and East Branch Snowmobile trails will be closed to snowmobile use on weekdays. The trails will be open for snowmobile use on weekends and Federal holidays. Riders should be aware that these trails, that also serve as roads, will be plowed and to expect those conditions. Those using the Switchback Trail should be aware of the temporary closure of Slippery Brook on weekdays. The width and location of Slippery Brook Road does not safely accommodate log truck and snowmobile traffic.
