- 1. MEETINGS i Annual Meeting The NHSA office shall send clubs a list of their members in good standing by March 31 of that year. Clubs must report their Delegates and Alternates in writing to the NHSA office by the registration deadline of April 15 of that year in order to be eligible to vote at the Annual Meeting. There shall not be more than one club Alternate for each Delegate registered for the Annual Meeting. Any registered Delegate or Alternate may represent and register to vote for a maximum of one club. One member is allowed one vote for the club they declared themselves to be a delegate for. All registered Delegates and Alternates must sign-in 10 minutes prior to the call to order to be recognized as a voting participant.
- 3. AMENDMENTS a. Any member of the Board of Directors or any Executive Officer may propose amendments to the New Hampshire Snowmobile Association Rules of Business. Amendments must be presented to the Board of Directors in writing. Amendments shall be voted on at a meeting of the Board of Directors held at least sixty (60) forty-five (45) days after the amendment(s) are submitted. Amendments must be adopted by a vote of five (5) Board of Directors or a 2/3 majority vote, whichever is larger.
